

Rumpke Residential Trash Guidelines

1. Trash must be placed at curb the night before pickup.
2. Limit of Six (6) 32 gallon cans or bags may be set out per pickup.
3. The weight limit for trash containers or bags is 50 lbs.
4. Loose materials such as shrubbery or lumber must be bundled and tied, and cannot exceed 4' in length, 2' in diameter and 50 lbs. in weight.
5. Rumpke is not responsible for damage to household containers, plastic cans or missing cans/containers and lids set at the curb. Drums, barrels, yard and household containers not acceptable will be removed as trash and not replaced.
6. Call 1-877-786-7537 twenty-four (24) hours in advance to make arrangements for any acceptable large items and/or excessive amounts of trash such as furniture or televisions, (there may be an extra charge).
7. Rumpke is not permitted by law to accept batteries, tires, liquids, combustible materials, or any materials deemed hazardous.
8. Rumpke is not permitted to transport items that contained Freon, such as Refrigerators and Air Conditioners. These items can be picked up if the Freon has been removed by a licensed professional with a certificate of removal. A Refrigerant Recover Statement must be attached to all appliances that use Freon. Call Rumpke at 1-877-786-7537 or go to rumpke.com to obtain a copy of the Refrigerant Recover Statement.
9. Bulky materials such as drywall, concrete, bricks, dirt or rocks will not be accepted.
10. Christmas Day and New Year's Day is observed, however, normal schedules for all other holidays.

City of Silver Grove Regulations for Trash Removal

1. All garage cans and trash containers shall be maintained in good condition and repair. All receptacles shall be provided with a cover sufficiently tight to prevent flies and/or other insects and/or animals from having access to the contents of the receptacles. Storage of garbage or trash in an open garbage can or trash container is not permitted.
2. Containers shall not be placed on the street right-of-way prior to noon, local time, on the day before scheduled collections, and shall be removed to the rear of premises before midnight, local time, the day of scheduled collections.
