

ARTICLE II

AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE

SECTION 2.0 AUTHORITY: The City Council of Silver Grove, Kentucky in pursuance of the authority of Kentucky Revised Statutes (K.R.S. 100.201-100.991) hereby ordains and enacts into law the following Articles and Sections.

SECTION 2.1 PURPOSE: The zoning regulations and districts as herein set forth have been prepared for the city of Silver Grove to promote the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the city, to facilitate orderly and harmonious development and the visual or historical character of the city, and to regulate the density of population and intensity of land use in order to provide for adequate light and air. In addition, this Ordinance has been prepared to provide for vehicle off-street parking and loading and/or unloading space, as well as to facilitate fire and police protection, and to prevent the overcrowding of land, blight, danger, and congestion in the circulation of people and commodities, and the loss of life, health or property from fire, flood or other dangers. The zoning regulations and districts as herein set forth are also employed to protect highway, and other transportation facilities, public facilities, including schools and public grounds, the central business district, natural resources and other specific areas in the city of Silver Grove which need special protection by the city.

ARTICLE II

AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE

SECTION 2.0. AUTHORITY: The City Council of Silver Grove, Kentucky in pursuance of the authority of Kentucky Revised Statutes (K.R.S. 100.201-100.221) hereby ordains and enacts into law the following Articles and Sections.

SECTION 2.1. PURPOSE: The zoning regulations and districts as herein set forth have been prepared for the city of Silver Grove to promote the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the city, to facilitate orderly and harmonious development and the visual or historical character of the city, and to regulate the density of population and intensity of land use in order to provide for adequate light and air. In addition, this Ordinance has been prepared to provide for vehicle off-street parking and loading and unloading zones, as well as to facilitate fire and police protection, and to prevent the overcrowding of land, blight, danger, and congestion in the circulation of people and commodities, and the loss of life, health or property from fire, flood or other dangers. The zoning regulations and districts as herein set forth are also employed to protect highways and other transportation facilities, public facilities, including schools and public grounds, and central business district, neutral mercantile and other specific areas in the city of Silver Grove which need special protection by the city.
