 - **Eagle Scout Projects-** Cameron has started buying supplies for the bird and bat houses.
 - **East First Street Reconstruction-** The final payment is still being held until the job is completed. Also, one storm sewer easement has not been signed by the home owners.

- **Riverfront Commons Trail Phase 1-** The easement drawings will be finished soon. The bid documents will be started on.

- Stated on June 27th Senate Bill 63 goes into effect. The bill allows ATVs / UTVs on State Roadways (excluding expressways). All KY Cities and County Governments must pass an ordinance to ALLOW these vehicles on city and county roads.
