- **Justin Verst, Viox & Viox, Project Updates:**
 - **KY Route 8 Sidewalk Phase 2-** Paperwork was sent to KYTC for approval of Jefferson Contracting. Authorization to proceed should be received within a couple weeks. A contract will be signed by Mayor Bedel and Jefferson Contracting once they are authorized. Once Jefferson Contracting is under contract a pre-construction meeting will be held, and then they can start construction.
 - **Eagle Scout Projects-** Cameron has purchased supplies for bird and bat houses. Derek's trail head at 3rd & Ash, and trail extension will start later this year.

- **East First Street Reconstruction-** Retainage has not been released. There are a few cracked street panels and some concrete finish issues in one area. Reimbursement from SD1 can be submitted once all easements are signed.
- **Riverfront Commons Trail Phase 1-** Duke Energy provided review comments and is asking for a few changes. After the plans are updated and Duke seems satisfied, they will be sent to CertainTeed.
