

# REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)

Repaving of ~800 Linear Feet of Residential Street

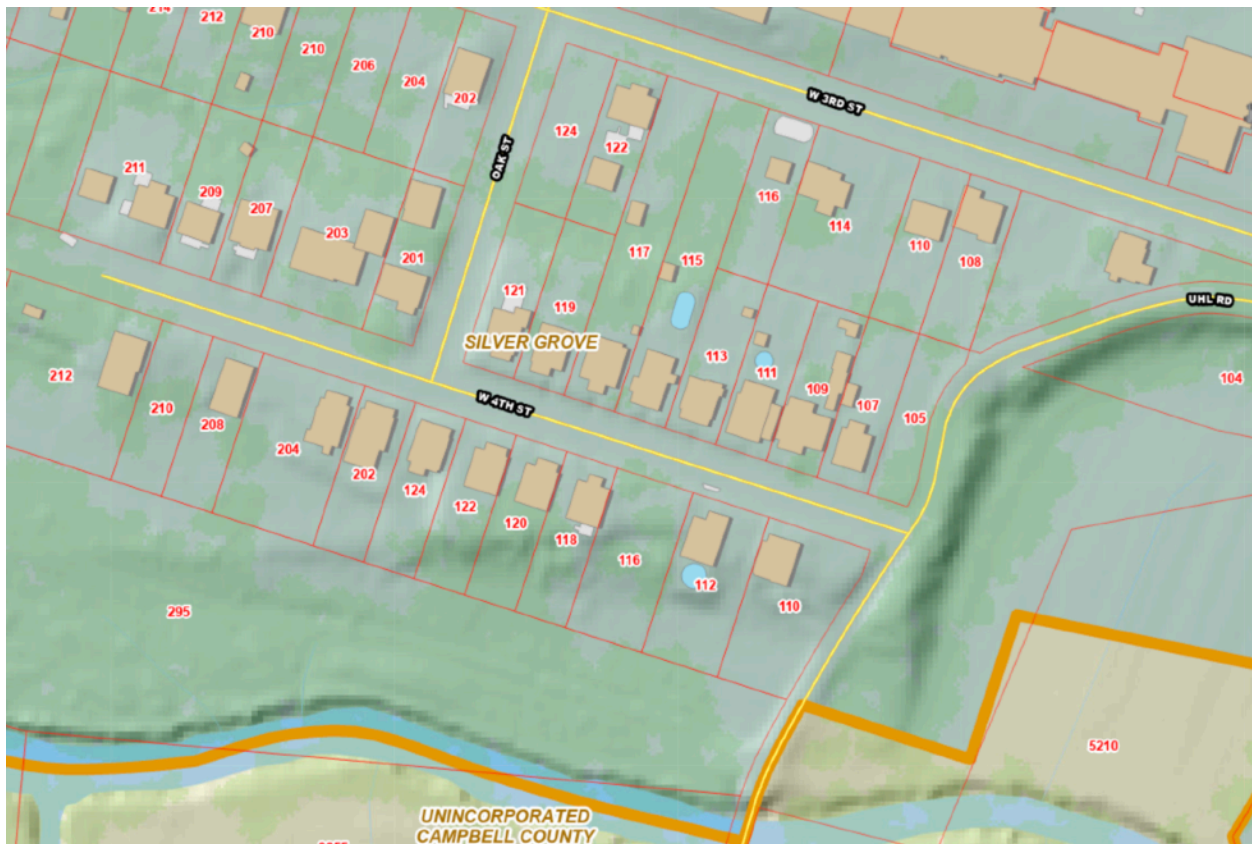

## 1. Introduction

The City of Silver Grove, Kentucky, is soliciting sealed proposals from qualified, licensed, and bonded paving contractors to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, and supervision necessary for the repaving of approximately 800 linear feet of an existing residential street.

**Project Location:** West Forth Street, west of Uhl Road to the end of the street in Silver Grove, KY. (See Map)



## **2. Project Description and Scope of Work**

The project involves the rehabilitation and repaving of an existing asphalt residential street. The work includes full-depth removal and replacement or milling and overlay, depending on the selected contractor's recommended approach and the City's approval.

### **Approximate Quantities (for bidding purposes):**

- Street length: 800 linear feet (verify on site)
- Existing pavement width: 26–30 feet (verify on site)

### **Major Work Items:**

#### **Site Preparation & Demolition**

- Saw-cut and remove existing asphalt pavement and base as needed.
- Remove and dispose of all debris, vegetation, and unsuitable material.
- Protect existing utilities, curbs, driveways, sidewalks, and landscaping.

#### **Subgrade & Base Course**

- Proof-roll and stabilize subgrade.
- Install/replace crushed aggregate base course (minimum 6–8 inches, compacted).

#### **Pavement Restoration**

- 3–4 inches of compacted Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) binder course + 2 inches HMA surface course (or per engineered recommendation).
- Taper and match existing pavement at project limits.

#### **Appurtenant Work**

- Adjust all utility structures (manholes, valves, etc.) to finished grade.
- Replace damaged curb, gutter, or sidewalks as encountered.
- Restore all driveway aprons and approaches.
- Install new pavement markings and striping (if applicable).
- Provide traffic control, signage, and pedestrian safety measures.

#### **Restoration**

Restore all disturbed lawns, landscaping, and drainage features.  
Clean site and leave in “broom-clean” condition.

## **3. Technical Specifications**

Adhere to the Campbell County Subdivision Regulations for Pavement Design. ([https://campbellcountyky.gov/egov/documents/1578510134\\_84475.pdf](https://campbellcountyky.gov/egov/documents/1578510134_84475.pdf))

### **Minimum requirements:**

All work to be performed by experienced crews under competent supervision.

## **4. Project Schedule (Tentative)**

- Notice to Proceed: On or before [Date]

- Substantial completion: Within 10 calendar days of start (weather permitting)
- Final walk-through and acceptance: Within 5 days of completion

### **5. Submittal Requirements**

Each bidder shall submit the following with their proposal:

- Completed Bid Form (attached or provided by bidder)
- Total lump-sum price (including all labor, materials, equipment, traffic control, striping, and adjustments)
- Detailed schedule showing start and completion dates
- Proof of General Liability Insurance (\$1,000,000 minimum per occurrence)
- Proof of Workers' Compensation Insurance
- Warranty information (minimum 1-year workmanship warranty required)

### **7. Evaluation Criteria**

Proposals will be evaluated based on:

- Total price (60%)
- Experience and references (20%)
- Proposed schedule and availability (10%)

- Completeness and responsiveness of bid (10%)

### **8. Terms & Conditions**

- Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
- Payment terms: Net 30 upon substantial completion and approval.
- 5% retainage held until final acceptance and punch-list completion.
- 1-year warranty against defects in materials and workmanship.
- All work to comply with local codes and ADA requirements.
