For years, one question has come up again and again in Silver Grove—what will happen to the old school building? Now, we finally have an answer.

The school has officially been sold, and new life is on the horizon.

The new owners are reimagining the building as a multi-purpose facility—a space designed to serve a variety of uses under one roof.

One of the key plans is to transform part of the building into an event venue, creating a place for weddings, celebrations, community events, and other gatherings. It's the kind of addition that could keep the building active and full of life while also drawing people into town.

The remainder of the building will be offered as leased suites for small businesses, services, or organizations. The focus isn't just on filling space, but on finding tenants that align with and add value to the Silver Grove community.

While change can feel bittersweet, especially for a building with so much history, this next chapter offers something meaningful: preservation through purpose. The school will continue to be a place where people gather, connect, and build something new—together.

More details will be shared as plans continue to develop, but for now, it's safe to say—after years of wondering, the future of the school is taking shape.

W 4TH STREET REPAVING PROJECT

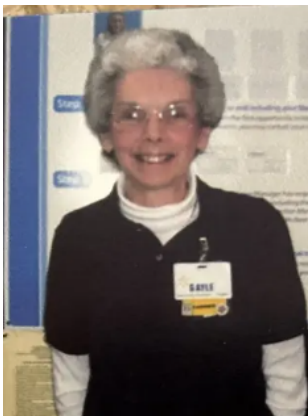
Silver Grove City Council approved a \$59,000 bid from Rieglers Blacktop at its August meeting to repave the entirety of W 4th Street.

The project will include work to the asphalt foundation and a new surface along the approximately 800-foot stretch of West Fourth Street.

Repaving is scheduled for the week of October 5 and is expected to take approximately three days to complete.

The project is part of the City's ongoing efforts to maintain and improve Silver Grove's streets and infrastructure.
